



College Advising and Application Support

We assist rising Seniors in understanding all components of the college process and the related timelines specific to their needs utilizing a streamlined, interactive online platform combined with in person advising.

Advising Services May Include:

- ❑ College planning orientation and overview.
- ❑ Guidance with college research, identifying likely, target, reach schools and college profile information.
- ❑ Access to our college admissions learning library: topics include: demonstrated interest, financial aid information, senior year checklists, testing, understanding application types, deadlines, and learning style inventories.
- ❑ SAT, ACT test policy guidance and timelines.
- ❑ Collegiate profile information, reports, access to counselor notes, essay requirements and topic organization (personal statement, PIQ, supplementals).
- ❑ Guidance and oversight for essays determined by a student's list*.
- ❑ Personalized prompting and To Do's throughout the application process.
- ❑ Application support for all application types: deadlines, application element requirements and individual timelines for submission.
- ❑ Activities resume support: identifying extracurricular activities, honors, awards, experiences to capture your student's strengths beyond the classroom.
- ❑ Guidance with Naviance interface or school procedures: transcripts, letters of recommendation, school profile, and parent/student counselor packets.
- ❑ Application feedback for accuracy and completeness.
- ❑ Interactive text feature, with us, as students work through the application process.

***Essay Support Includes:** Identification of essays required, organization of essay topics, general discussion of topics and feedback. Students should be strong writers, able to take direction, follow deadlines and revise efficiently.



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Please note: Essays are one component of many application elements. We have a limited amount of time to spend on essay work as there are many other components involved in the application. Students needing more extensive essay support may want to consider working with a local essay specialist in addition to their work with us.

Junior Year Spring Early Start

Includes spring senior year coursework discussion and testing guidance. Early access to resources, college planning discussions and summer application work: assistance building/refining a balanced college list and getting a jump start on the application process with summer assignments. Includes up to 6 individual meetings and review of up to 10 applications (UC App and CSU App each count as 1 application).

Fall Quick Start

Designed for Seniors needing immediate assistance. Students jump in quickly with all application elements. Includes up to 4 individual meetings and review of up to 10 applications (UC App and CSU App count as 1 application). Limited essay support/feedback.

All student application work is to be completed between August 1 - Mid December.
